

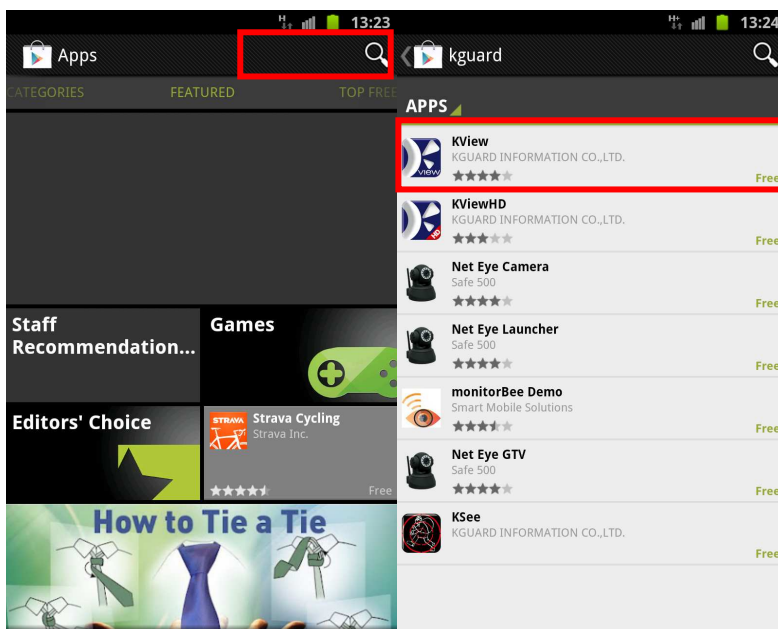
How to download and setup KView on Android OS



Step 1:

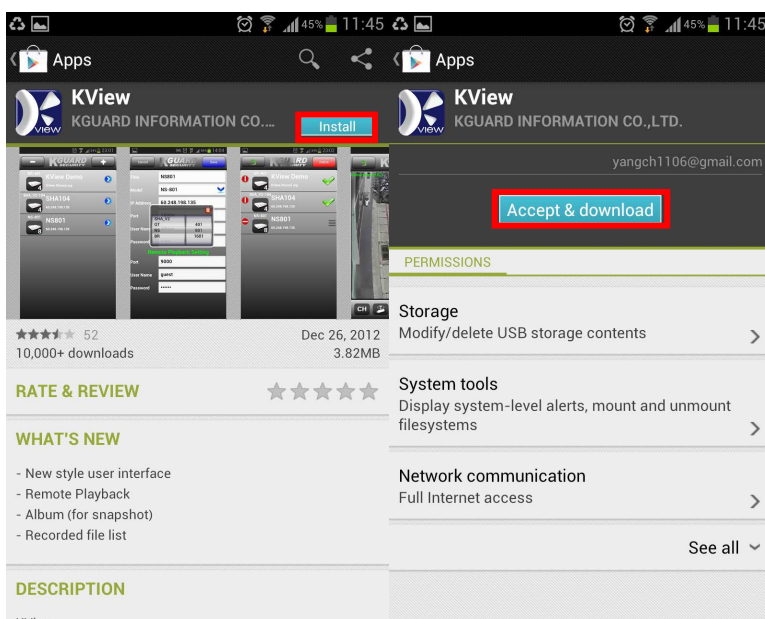
Go to “Play Store”.

You can find “Play Store” on Main screen or in Application



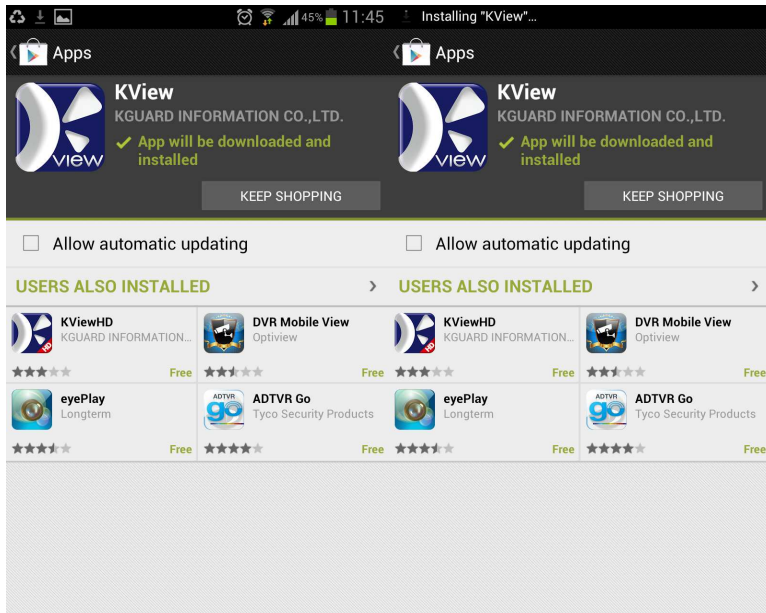
Step 2:

Enter “kguard” keyword to search, and then select “KView” app



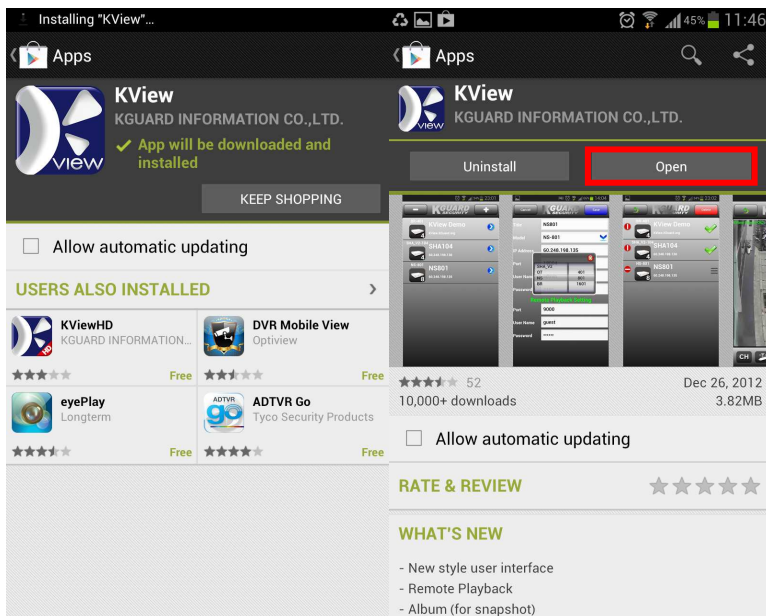
Step 3:

Touch “Download” and then touch “Accept & download”



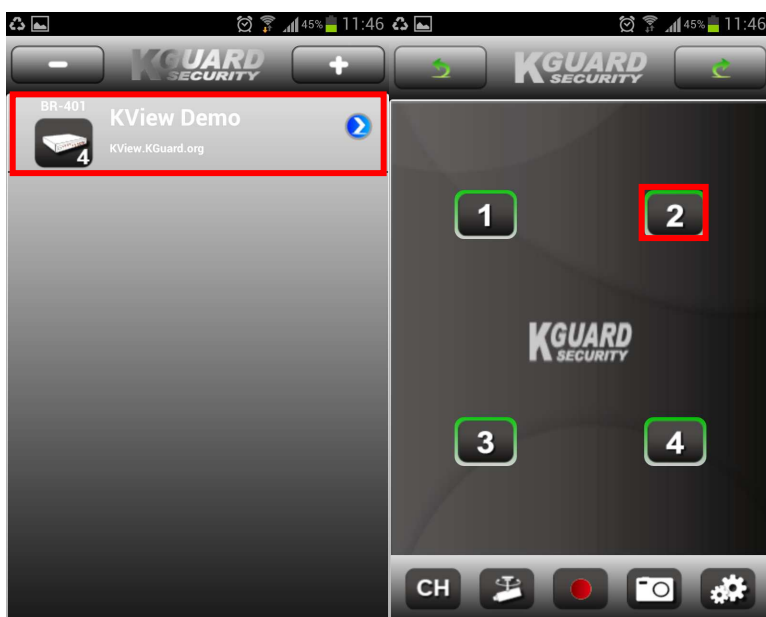
Step 4:

Android will download and install KView. Download time will depend on your network bandwidth.



Step 5:

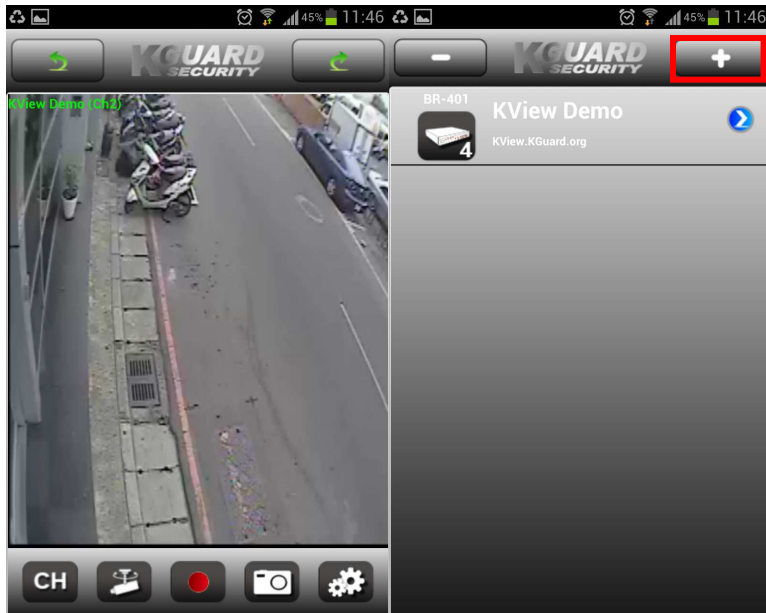
After KView install complete, touch “Open” to run KView.



Step 6:

KView have a default demo site for user to connect and check if network is OK. You can touch “KView Demo” to connect and select CH number. If you can see our demo site camera video, your network is OK.

Touch “Settings” button to enter KView settings

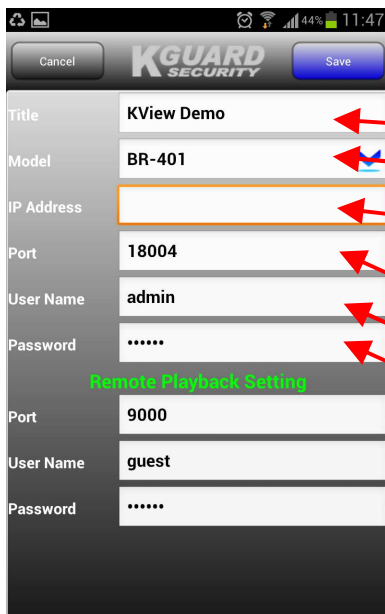


Step 7:

If you can see our demo site camera video, your network is OK.

Touch green arrow on left to return

Touch “+” button to add new dvr



Step 8:

You can enter DVR info
